In compliance to the judgment delivered by the Hon'ble High Court of HP on dated 23.05.2022 in CWP No. 1651 of 2022 titled Ashish Kumar V/s State of Himachal Pradesh, wherein, the Hon'ble High Court of HP has set aside the notice (directing the students not to resign from already allocated PG MD/MS seats dated 19.03.2022 as the same is contrary to the Clause 2.3 of the Prospectus. **Therefore, the provisional PG (MD/MS) seat allocations made in the Mop Up Round held on 7-5-2022 and thereafter stands cancelled.**


In view of the above, all the registered candidates desirous to take admission in PG (MD/MS Courses seats under 50% State Quota (including those intending to change of specialties /upgrade their PG(MD / MS) seats allocated in earlier rounds of the counseling) are directed to attend the **Mop up round of counseling in physical mode on 30th May, 2022 at Examination Hall HP Govt. Dental College, Indira Gandhi Medical College Shimla at 10:30 AM.**

The candidates will have to surrender already occupied seats on the spot before opting for up gradation during the Mop-Up round of Counselling, failing which the up gradation / allocation of new seat will not be allowed.

The candidates are advised to bring their all relevant documents and Educational Certificates (in original) and requisite fee amounting to Rs.39,000/- at the time of Counselling failing which seat will not be allotted to them and will be filled up next in order of merit.

The candidates who have taken admissions under All India Quota in earlier round are not eligible to attend the Mop-Up round of Counselling.
